BYLAWS COMMITTEE REPORT

The Bylaws Committee received a request to review the following:

Article V: Officers/Governing Board

Need clarification regarding current and immediate past president, and if officers remain the same, how KMCA handles that in the future. The current president is also the immediate past president. The following was suggested:

- > Eliminate the immediate past president position because it is not recognized by Robert's Rules of Order and there is not a job description for immediate past president. (No job duties are listed in the Bylaws for immediate past president.)
- ➤ If the position of immediate past president is not eliminated, the bylaws need to clarify that this position is not an elected position, is or is not a member of the Executive Board (currently listed that it is), what to do when the current president is also the past president, and does the position need job duties like the rest of the Executive Board.

Other suggestions to Article V:

- > Ensure a vacancy on the Executive Board does not exist in the future
- > Create language that clarifies that a person cannot hold more than one Executive Board Office
- ➤ Determine if the IIMC Region V Director position should be considered an Officer of the Executive Board. (The first sentence states the Region V position is an executive officer, need to ensure that there is no conflicting language.)
- > Determine if Regional Representatives should be required to have their CKMC to serve
- > Clarify if the slate of newly elected officers can be shared before spring conference; if current officers and new officers could be told, they could go ahead and work out transferring duties.

Outcome:

The Bylaws Committee reviewed Article V and the requests received. A draft of the amended article was sent to the KMCA Board for their review. The Bylaw Committee's recommendations were approved

by the Board on March 15, 2019. Voting information and ballots were put on the KMCA Facebook page on March 29, 2019. The ballots and information were e-mailed to the KMCA membership and placed on KMCA's website on April 1, 2019. Ballots are due May 6, 2019.
