



# THE DAVID B. SMITH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

## BACKGROUND

The Kentucky League of Cities recognizes the critical role city clerks play in quality governance. To acknowledge the service of clerks, KLC began funding the David B. Smith Memorial Scholarship in 2009. David B. Smith was a person of great humor and warmth. He was a KLC employee who was well-known to many city clerks. David passed away on Sept. 7, 2007. The David B. Smith Scholarship is KLC's way to keep David's commitment to cities ongoing and to assist a group of professionals for which he had so much respect - Kentucky's city clerks.

## PURPOSE AND SCOPE

- The David B. Smith Scholarship provides six eligible recipients \$500 for training expenses, including registration and travel. KLC will award up to \$3,000 in scholarships per year.
- The David B. Smith Scholarship may be used for costs associated with attending the 2024 Kentucky Municipal Clerks Institute (KMCI) or the 2024 Kentucky Master Municipal Clerks Academy (KMMCA).

## ELIGIBILITY

- Applicant must be a full-time municipal clerk, assistant city clerk, deputy city clerk, or in a position performing the duties commensurate to duties performed by a municipal clerk.
- Applicant must be a member and in good standing with KMCA and KLC.
- All applications must be returned by Feb. 29, 2024.
- The KMCA Board will select eligible recipients primarily based on the financial need of the city.
- Recipients will be notified in writing by KLC after the KMCA Board makes its recommendation.
- KLC will issue the scholarship to the individual recipient's city government.
- In the unlikely event that a recipient cannot attend KMCI or KMMCA, KLC may choose to select an alternate suggested by KMCA or withhold a portion of the scholarship for the year.
